

Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.


Angela had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Angela received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$1,501 (that is 15.01% of her initial \$10,000). Angela did not pay any other charges. This gives Angela a total return after tax of \$1,501 for the year.

* As the fund started in October 2017 returns for a full calendar year are unavailable. This example is based on the market index annual return less the estimated fees above.

Notes
